The New Translation of the order of the Mass

For the next ten weeks we shall be introducing the words of the New translation of the mass in our bulletin, to prepare ourselves for the changes in advent.

In most cases the changes to what the people say during Mass will be minor. The Change that occurs most frequently is in the response that the people make during the short dialogue during mass.

At the beginning of Mass, after the sign of the cross, the celebrant will have a choice of three greetings, similar to the ones used currently. The people will reply "*And with your spirit*" This translation is closer to the Latin original than "And also with you." This change also applies in a number of other places in the Mass.

Before the proclamation of the Gospel, the priest or deacon will say "The Lord be with you." The people will reply "And with your spirit." The rest of the dialogue will be the same as at present.

At the sign of peace, the celebrant will say "The peace of the Lord be with you always." The people response will be "And with your Spirit."

At the end of the of the Mass, before the final blessing, the celebrant will say "The Lord be with you." As before, the people will reply "And with your spirit."
