New Translation of the Order of the Mass**The Apostles' Creed**

While the **Nicene Creed** will continue to be used as the **Profession of Faith**, There will be a number of changes to the translation.

Most significantly, the use of “**we**” will be replaced by the use of “**I**”. So it will begin with the words “**I believe in one God**,” and will end with “**I confess one baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come**”

There will also be other minor changes, such as the replacement of the phrase “**of one being with the father**” with the more theological “**consubstantial with the father.**”
