**The New Translation of the order of the Mass****The Glory to God**

There will be a number of changes to the *Glory to God*, which will make the text closer to the Latin original.

The words "and peace to his people on earth" will be replaced by "*and on earth peace to people of good will*".

The second sentence has been re-phrased and will read "**We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory, Lord God, heavenly king, O God, almighty Father.**"

The third sentence has also been expanded to include the repetitions in the Latin: "**Lord Jesus Christ, Only begotten son, Lord God, Lamb of God, son of the father, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us; you take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer; you are seated at the right hand of the father, have mercy on us.**"

This new version of the *Glory to God* cannot be sung to musical settings currently in use.
