Standard, installed equipment by location

St Joseph's Subiaco has four main function and event areas:

The Upper Room



Installed equipment – complimentary with room:

- Data Projector with VGA and composite inputs*
- In roof sound (mono) with composite balanced inputs or 3.5mm stereo jack
- Handheld wireless mic
- Lapel wireless mic
- WiFi

*USB, HDMI and DVI inputs are available at an additional cost of \$35 per input as a tech is required

The Piazza



This is an outdoor area and stands ready with 3 phase, 10 and 15 amp power boxes. We recommend hiring one of our packages to service this area and if the event is a late afternoon or evening function we would recommend also hiring lighting.

The Church



Our beautiful Catholic church was built in the early 1930's and opened in 1933. It has a rich natural acoustic sound but for larger concerts or conferences we highly recommend the use of our new in house powered system.

The system was installed in late 2011 and features:

- 2 x 15' & horn active top boxes at the front
- 2 x 12' & horn active top boxes at the mid-way mark
- 1 x 18' active 1,400 watt sub
- 16 channel desk with post EQ and FX
- 2 x foldback loops
- 2 x 10' horn powered (active) foldbacks
- Multicore and access plates including routing and patching
- Wireless SM 58 Vocal Quality Microphone
- 4 SM 58 wired mic
- 2 active DI's
- Choir condensers
- Instrument mics
- Controllable house lighting (not DMX enabled)

This new system is hired at an additional cost and does not come standard with the venue hire price.

The standard equipment made available as part of the venue hire price for the church is only the mono, older, in house system which is designed only for high quality voice. Included with this in-house system you have access to:

1 x lectern (ambo) fixed mic

1 x lapel mic (wireless)

1 x headset mic (wireless)

1 x CD player for background music only

4 x installed condenser microphones in the choir loft (not adjustable)

For a concert or large event we suggest looking at one of our two package options for the church which can be found in section 3 of this info pack.

The church also features 3 phase power and has an entirely 'clean' independently earthed audio circuit to ensure there is no interference from lighting or other circuits.

Package Pricing

We offer two main packages which are designed for use in either the church or outdoors on the piazza. Please note though however that we can also mix and match equipment to suit your needs and budget.

Package One – Self Operated

Equipment included:

- Active, 2,400 Watt Front of House System
- Active 1,400 Watt Sub
- 1 x wireless SM 58 mic on boom arm stand
- 2 x wired SM 58 mics on boom arm stands
- 1 x DI (for keyboards or Acoustic Guitar)+
- 1 x powered foldback

This system would be very suitable for a wedding, small concert, funeral or liturgical service that had a music group or band playing.

It would also suit a DJ playing for a wedding reception upstairs in the upper room or on the piazza.

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Package Two – Operator Included

Equipment included:

- Active, 3,600 Watt Front of House System
- Active 1,400 Watt Sub
- 16 channels of sound plus FX
- 1 x wireless SM 58 mic on boom arm stand
- 4 x wired SM 58 mics on boom arm stands
- 2 x DI's (for keyboards or acoustic guitars)
- 4 x Choir or instrument condensers
- 3 x powered foldbacks
- 1 x multicore
- Operator for 4 hours (this must include any rehearsals or setup times)

This system package is for larger events; large concerts or any event booking that requires an experienced tech onsite to ensure both the sound quality and system is tailored and extremely professional.

Call out and in house tech policy



When paying to hire one of our systems free 24/7 tech support is available for faults only. Hooking up your laptop to the data projector, mixing of mics etc are NOT faults.

If a tech is called out and the fault is found with your equipment or because you did not know how to hook the equipment up, you will be charged the call out fee accordingly.

If you are not tech savvy or need to focus on your event's presentation why not pre book a tech at only \$45 per hour to take care of your AV needs.

It is important to note that when hiring Package One you do not get a tech included in the rate, however if you simply wanted a tech to do the sound check and customise the sound for you, you could pre book a tech for one hour for set up and sound check and then be left to perform.

St Joseph's takes no responsibility for any issues that may arise from you're not having sufficient knowledge to manage the system and no person is permitted to touch or alter any of the settings of the system, only a St Joseph's tech is able to do this.

Equipment Hire T&C's

1. Definitions

1.1 In these Terms and Conditions unless the context otherwise requires:

- (a) Business Day is a normal working day excluding Saturdays, Sundays and gazetted Public Holidays in the state in which the Equipment is delivered or collected from St Joseph's.
- (b) Clause means a clause of these Terms and Conditions.
- (c) Equipment means the Equipment supplied to Customer by St Joseph's from time to time.
- (d) Force Majeure means an act, omission or circumstance over which St Joseph's could not have reasonably exercised control.
- (e) Delivery Advice means the attached Delivery Advice.
- (f) Party means a Party to these Terms and Conditions and its successors, trustees and permitted assigns.
- (g) Penalty Interest Rate means the rate prescribed by Section 2 of the Penalty Interest Rates Act 1993 (Cth).
- (h) Rental Period means the period commencing on the date of delivery of Equipment or Commencement Date, whichever is the later; and concluding on the later of: (i) 3:00 pm on Conclusion Date; or (ii) if Conclusion Date is not a Business Day, 3.00 pm of the next Business Day after the Conclusion Date; or (iii) if Equipment is returned damaged, 3.00 pm on the date that Equipment is repaired by St Joseph's or the replacement cost of Equipment is paid by Customer.
- (i) Sub-clause means a Sub-clause of these Terms and Conditions.
- (j) Terms and Conditions means these Terms and Conditions.
- (k) St Joseph's is defined as St Joseph's Pty Ltd and its associated companies and subsidiaries.

1.2 Items appearing in bold type in these Terms and Conditions shall be interpreted as defined terms.

2. Interpretation

2.1 In the Interpretation of these Terms and Conditions unless the context otherwise requires:

- (a) Words denoting a person shall include corporations, statutory corporations, partnerships, joint ventures, associations, boards, governments or semi-government agencies or authorities.
- (b) Words denoting the singular number shall include the plural number and vice versa.
- (c) Words denoting any gender shall include all other genders.
- (d) A reference to a statute or a regulation also refers to any statute or regulation amending, or consolidating or re-enacting same.
- (e) Money references are references to Australian currency.
- (f) Headings used in this Terms and Conditions are for convenience and ease of reference only, and are not part of these Terms and Conditions and shall not be relevant or affect the meaning or Interpretation of these Terms and Conditions.
- (g) Every obligation, covenant, agreement, condition express or implied in these Terms and Conditions and entered into by more than one Party shall bind them jointly and each of them severally.
- (h) If any provision or part provision of these Terms and Conditions is held invalid, unenforceable or illegal for any reason, these Terms and Conditions shall remain otherwise in full force apart from such provision or part provision, which shall be deemed deleted.
- (i) These Terms and Conditions take precedence over any Delivery Docket, quotation or any other agreement, verbal or written.

3. Scope

3.1 St Joseph's shall provide Equipment for duration of the Rental Period.

3.2 Provided that Customer has not breached any provision of these Terms and Conditions, Rental Period may be extended at the request of Customer at the sole discretion of St Joseph's.

3.3 In the event that the Equipment is not returned by the expiration of the Rental Period then at the sole option of St Joseph's a further fee shall become due and payable and such shall continue to accrue on the expiration of the renewed Rental Period until the Equipment is returned. In the event that Equipment is returned prior to the expiration of the Rental Period or any extended Rental Period then St Joseph's may give a rebate on the Hire Fees but is not obliged to do so. No claim shall be made or maintainable if St Joseph's determines not to give a rebate. Nothing in this Sub-clause shall oblige St Joseph's to so extend a Rental Period.

3.4 The Customer acknowledges that all delivery and collection times are approximate and late delivery or collection shall not entitle the Customer to terminate this agreement or claim any other form of release against St Joseph's.

4. Customer's Obligations

4.1 Customer shall:

- (a) pay St Joseph's all fees and charges payable including without limitation, Hire Fees, Service Fees, Delivery Costs, Collection Costs and Consumables.
- (b) collect and return Equipment from and to the Delivery Address in a method approved by St Joseph's. In particular, but without limitation, Customer shall not post Equipment.
- (c) make all appropriate enquiries about Equipment's fitness for the purposes for which it is hired or used by Customer and shall determine whether Equipment is fit for that purpose and is in a condition suitable for use.
- (d) use Equipment only for the purpose for which it is manufactured or designed and in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- (e) keep Equipment insured and be responsible for any loss or damage to the Equipment, either by fire, theft, vandalism, weather conditions, flood, water or any eventuality whatsoever and shall indemnify St Joseph's and hold St Joseph's harmless for any loss or damage in fact suffered other than through fair wear and tear in the normal course of use.
- (f) clean the Equipment and return it to St Joseph's in a clean condition, properly maintained in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations.
- (g) not sell, charge, pledge or part with possession of Equipment;
- (h) keep Equipment at the address specified unless written permission has been obtained from St Joseph's to relocate Equipment elsewhere;
- (i) keep Equipment in a careful and proper manner and not interfere or tamper with or let anyone else do so;
- (j) return Equipment in the same packaging as delivery was made in. St Joseph's reserves the right to charge for packaging materials that are not returned.
- (k) permit St Joseph's its agents or servants to enter the premises where Equipment is located at all reasonable times in order to inspect Equipment or carry out repairs to Equipment.

5. Risk

5.1 Risk for the Equipment passes to the Customer when the Equipment leaves the premises of St Joseph's and ceases when the Equipment is delivered into the safe possession of St Joseph's at the premises.

5.2 Customer is responsible for the safekeeping of the Equipment and shall bear the risk of any loss, theft, damage or destruction of Equipment.

5.3 In the event that the Equipment requires repair as a result of Customer's negligence, misuse or abuse, Customer shall bear cost of any such repair including any freight charges.

5.4 Customer shall pay St Joseph's the new replacement cost as assessed by St Joseph's of the Equipment which is lost, stolen, destroyed or damaged beyond repair.

5.5 Customer shall pay St Joseph's a reasonable refurbishing fee in the event that ownership labels, or other notices affixed to Equipment are removed or defaced.

5.6 Any item of non-expendable material (including operations manuals) not returned to St Joseph's upon cessation of the Rental Period shall be charged to the account of the Customer at full replacement cost or \$50 which ever shall be the greater amount.

6. Maintenance

6.1 St Joseph's shall at its expense provide routine maintenance and recalibration for Equipment and shall use its best endeavours to expeditiously repair or replace Equipment which becomes defective during the Rental Period through no fault of the Customer.

6.2 In the event that the Equipment does not operate properly Customer shall immediately notify St Joseph's and request instructions before taking remedial action.

6.3 St Joseph's may at its option and for such length of time as it deems expedient replace Equipment with another of such type or model as shall for the time being be available and Equipment so substituted shall be subject to these Terms and Conditions. (a) St Joseph's shall not be liable if the defect is a result of: (i) Improper use; (ii) operation of Equipment other than in accordance with the operating manual; (iii) modification of Equipment; (iv) use of Equipment in an environment other than that for which it was designed; (v) use of Equipment by a person other than Customer; (vi) Customer's failure to allow maintenance of Equipment; (vii) The serial number or labels being removed or replaced.

7. Limited Warranty and Exclusion of Liability

7.1 St Joseph's warrants that each item of Equipment hired is of merchantable quality and reasonably fit for the purpose for which it was designed. All other warranties whether express, implied, statutory or otherwise, relating in any way to the subject matter of these Terms and Conditions are excluded.

7.2 Where legislation implies in these Terms and Conditions any condition or warranty and that legislation avoids or prohibits provisions in a contract excluding or modifying the application of or the exercise of or liability under such term, such term shall be deemed to be included in these Terms and Conditions. However, the liability of St Joseph's for any breach of such term shall be limited, at the option of St Joseph's, to any one or more of the following:

- (a) if the breach related to goods: the replacement of the goods or the supply of equivalent goods; the repair of such goods; the payment of the cost of replacing the goods or of acquiring equivalent goods; or the payment of the cost of having the goods repaired; and

(b) if the breach relates to services the supplying of the services again; or the payment of the cost of having the services supplied again.

7.3 Subject only to Clause 7.2, St Joseph's shall not be under any liability to Customer in respect of any loss or damage (including, without limitation, consequential loss or damage) however caused, which may be suffered or incurred or which may arise directly or indirectly in respect to the supply of goods or services pursuant to these Terms and Conditions or the failure or omission on the part of St Joseph's to comply with its obligations under these Terms and Conditions including, without limitation, negligence.

8. Title

8.1 St Joseph's retains all rights, including without limitation any intellectual property rights, and title in Equipment.

8.2 Customer acknowledges that its use of the Microsoft Software accompanying the Equipment rented is governed by the attached Microsoft End User Licence Agreement.

8.3 The use of any Software supplied by St Joseph's is subject to the Terms and Conditions of the relevant End User Licence Agreement which is incorporated into these Terms and Conditions.

9. Purchase of Equipment

9.1 In the event that the Customer seeks to purchase the Equipment and St Joseph's agrees to sell the Equipment the property therein shall not pass until and unless all Hire Fees and the purchase price have been received by St Joseph's and the payments shall be applied first in reduction of Hire Fees and second on account of the purchase price. Hire Fees shall continue to accrue until the full purchase price has been paid.

10. Force Majeure

10.1 St Joseph's shall not be liable for any delay or failure to perform its obligations if such a failure or delay is due to Force Majeure.

11. Waiver

11.1 No right of St Joseph's shall be deemed to be waived except by notice in writing from St Joseph's.

11.2 Any failure by St Joseph's to enforce any clause of these Terms and Conditions, or any forbearance, delay or indulgence granted by a Party will not be construed as a waiver of St Joseph's rights.

12. Notices

12.1 Notices under these Terms and Conditions may be delivered by hand, by mail, facsimile or email to the address set out in the Delivery Docket.

12.2 Notices shall be deemed given, in the case of:

- (a) hand delivery, upon written acknowledgment of receipt by an officer or other duly authorised employee, agent or representative of the receiving Party;
- (b) posting, three days after dispatch;
- (c) facsimile, upon completion of transmission; and
- (d) e-mail, immediately after dispatch.

13. Fees

13.1 Customer shall pay St Joseph's the Hire Fees on delivery, in advance or within 7 days of invoice (unless specified otherwise in Delivery Docket) without withholding, deduction or offset of any amounts for any purpose.

13.2 St Joseph's may increase its Hire Fees at any time upon thirty (30) days' notice to Customer.

13.3 Except to the extent stated to the contrary in a Delivery Docket, Hire Fees are exclusive of taxes, duties, fees or other government levies or charges which may be imposed on or in respect of the Equipment. Such taxes, duties, fees or other government charges shall to the extent permissible by law be paid by Customer to St Joseph's.

13.4 Customer shall pay St Joseph's interest at the Penalty Interest Rate on all overdue amounts from the due date until payment is made.

13.5 If any payment owing to St Joseph's is not made within seven (7) days of the due date, St Joseph's may, without further notice to Customer, suspend further services or its remaining obligations to Customer under these Terms and Conditions.

14. Termination

14.1 Without limiting the generality of any other clause in these Terms and Conditions, St Joseph's may terminate these Terms and Conditions or any Delivery Docket immediately by notice in writing if:

- (a) any payment due from Customer to St Joseph's pursuant to these Terms and Conditions remains unpaid for a period of seven (7) days;
- (b) Customer breaches any provision of these Terms and Conditions and such breach is not remedied immediately upon receipt of notice by St Joseph's as defined by clause 12 herein;
- (c) Customer is otherwise no longer capable of complying with its obligations under these Terms and Conditions; or
- (d) Customer becomes, threatens or resolves to become or is in jeopardy of becoming subject to any form of insolvency administration; Customer, being a partnership, dissolves, threatens or resolves to dissolve or is in jeopardy of dissolving; Customer being a natural person, dies; or Customer ceases or threatens to cease conducting its business in the normal manner.

14.2 If these Terms and Conditions or any Delivery Docket is terminated then St Joseph's may in its sole discretion:

- (a) retain all moneys paid, which is agreed to be a genuine estimate of part of St Joseph's loss and damage suffered;
- (b) charge a reasonable sum for Equipment supplied in respect of which no sum has been previously charged;
- (c) be regarded as discharged from any further obligations under these Terms and Conditions; and
- (d) enter upon the premises of Customer, the consent to which is hereby granted by Customer, and repossess the Equipment. All such reasonable costs of repossession are the responsibility of Customer and shall be added to Hire Fees.
- (e) pursue any additional or alternative remedies provided by law.

14.3 The covenants, conditions and provisions of these Terms and Conditions which are capable of having effect after the expiration of these Terms and Conditions shall remain in full force and effect following the expiration of the Terms and Conditions.

15. Entire Agreement

15.1 These Terms and Conditions constitute the entire agreement between the parties for the subject matter referred to in these Terms and Conditions. Any prior arrangements, including without limitation, verbal arrangements, agreements, representations or undertakings are superseded.

15.2 No modification, variation or alteration of any provision of these Terms and Conditions shall be valid except in writing signed by each Party.

16. Governing Law

16.1 These Terms and Conditions will be governed by and construed according to the law of the State of Western Australia.

16.2 The parties irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of Western Australia and Australia and any Courts hearing appeals from such Courts.
