PLENARY COUNCIL LETTER FROM ARCHBISHOP COSTELLOE

As you may have heard Pope Francis, in giving his approval for the Plenary Council to be held in 2020/2021, also ratified the proposal that I be appointed as President of the Plenary Council. I look forward to contributing to this important event in the life of the Church. A National Executive Committee which will coordinate and oversee the preparations for the plenary has been established by the Bishops Conference. The committee has already begun working and is well advance in terms of planning.

There is also a Bishops Commission for the Plenary Council, chaired by Archbishop Coleridge, Archbishop of Brisbane. I am a member of this commission, together with Archbishop Wilson (Adelaide), Bishop Long (Parramatta), Bishop Kennedy (Armidale), and Bishop Tarabay (Maronite Eparchy of Australia).

Debra Sayce (CEWA) and I have begun gathering a group of people to form a coordination and oversight group at the diocesan level. This group will be meeting, and its membership finalised, on 7 April. Lana Turvey-Collins will be present to lead the day's proceedings. Because of the importance of the Plenary Council I have asked Mr Tony Giglia to undertake the role of Diocesan Coordinator for the Plenary. Tony has enthusiastically accepted this offer and I look forward to the whole archdiocese benefitting from his energy, commitment and expertise.

There has not been a Plenary Council held in Australia since 1937. It is my hope that every person and every community in our archdiocese will engage with the Plenary Council with enthusiasm, in a spirit of hope and expectation, and with deep trusting faith in the guiding presence of God's Holy Spirit. And as always, the leadership of our clergy will be the key to success.

Please keep alert for regular updates and information as the weeks and months go by. 2020 is really not all that far away!
