

PLENARY COUNCIL 2020: PARISH LAUNCH



Pope Francis has approved the Australian Bishops' decision to hold a Plenary Council in Australia in 2020 and 2021. It is a significant moment for the Church in Australia to make decisions about the future. Archbishop Costelloe has been appointed as President of the Plenary Council by Pope Francis and as Chairman of the Bishops' Commission on the Plenary. This is an opportunity for Catholics whether deeply engaged and at peace with the Church, marginalised, vulnerable or distant from the Church, to speak what is in their minds and in their hearts. In the coming months we will gather together to listen to one another, to reflect on this question and share our own stories of faith, and our experiences of the Church. After we talk together, we will collate our stories and ideas and the questions we have about the future of the Church in Australia and give our submissions online through the Plenary Council webpage. For the voice of all people to be heard we need you. Please consider joining up as a conversation partner at plenarycouncil.catholic.org.au. Membership is free, and there are helpful resources for reading and viewing. The Plenary Council 2020 candle is located on the Sanctuary and will be lit before each Mass.

The Plenary Council is a process of listening and dialogue around the question: **What do you think God is asking of us in Australia today?**
