**ST JOSEPH’S PARISH VISITING SPEAKER PROGRAM**

**Upper Room, Wednesday 3 & Thursday 4 July**

As part of the Parish’s commitment to ongoing opportunities for listening and dialogue as we journey towards the Plenary 2020, and in partnership with the Archdiocese of Perth, we have invited Daniel Ang (member of the Plenary Council 2020 Executive, and Director of Parish 2020, Archdiocese of Sydney) to facilitate two opportunities within our Parish to further our conversations about how we as a local church may be signposts of renewal and life.

**Session 1: Principles of Our Evangelising Mission**

**6-7.30pm, Wednesday 3 July**

This session will explore the way in which a parish may become more fully alive and a Church for all people by considering principles or essential foundations central to an evangelising parish. It will address the subject of pre-evangelisation, how we may proclaim the good news, the personal nature of faith’s reception and the cultivation of a deeper Christian identity both within and beyond the parish.

**Session 2: Making Disciples in the Australian Parish**

**9.45-11.15am, Thursday 4 July**

This session will consider the pastoral reality and opportunities for the Church in Australia, noting the local parish as indispensable to our spiritual identity as Church. This session will name the ‘fruit’ of evangelising parishes as discipleship and recognise the complexity of people we encounter in ministry today. It will propose that a renewed vision for making disciples, and a preference for processes over programs, are integral to the movement from maintenance to mission.
