**SERVING ACTIVE COMPASSION – A CSM STORY**

The 14th Dalai Lama says, "what unites us is not shared politics or the same religion. It's something simpler: a shared belief in compassion." Our Governor General Sir Peter Cosgrove describing NZ Prime Minister Jacinda Arden's reaction after the mass shooting as, "A tactile sense of compassion". These quotes remind us of our responsibility to foster 'active compassion'. As a parish, we are fortunate to have an overseas outreach program in Calcutta Stations Mission (CSM). Earlier in the year we guided a pilgrimage to our mission in Kolkata, India. Over the next couple of weeks some of the pilgrims will share with us their thoughts and prayers in the Parish Bulletin as they experienced our mission first hand. This is some of my personal story ...

Helping our founder Rod Pereira for close to 15 years, it was on this pilgrimage that a profound reality hit me.

*For those not familiar with CSM, we run three main programs: a food program, a scholarship program for young women and sponsoring a remote school we built.*

*Some people over the years have questioned the long-term benefit of the food program. The other two programs are education based where easy evidence can be seen for far reaching individual, family and community benefit. The Food Program was our first program, providing meals every day for close to 15 years now. Here's a day in the life of our food program:*

*A freshly prepared meal arrives with a smiling face. Daily, our social workers attend to the chosen few. We assess those most needy of the many homeless, mainly abandoned widows and mentally ill older men, in and around one of the busiest train stations in Kolkata.*

*We start by giving the people we serve a drink of water and washing their hands. Basic hygiene and rehydration with a kind word is as valuable as the nourishment provided in the food. At the insistence of our founder from day 1 we serve a good variety of traditional Indian food freshly prepared daily by a local canteen.*

*Rod's aim is to deliver dignity to those who have been forgotten.*

Back to my recent pilgrimage experience; what hit me for the first time after all these years, upon hearing that some of our people on the food program had recently passed away, was that our meals are all too often the last meal before end of life. For us to provide a stranger with their last meal, is fostering 'active compassion'. **Next week we'll hear stories from some of our pilgrims. God Bless.**
