NATIONAL SORRY DAY & RECONCILIATION WEEK


26 May - 3 June

National Sorry Day is 26 May. This annual day of commemoration and remembrance for all those who have been impacted by the government policies of forcible removal that resulted in the Stolen Generation. It is a time for all Australians to reflect on the profound grief and trauma experienced by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and an opportunity to celebrate their strength and resilience, and to reaffirm our shared commitment to truth, justice and healing.

Reconciliation Week is the national week to celebrate and build respectful relationships between Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and all Australians. The week begins on 27 May, the 50th anniversary of the 1967 referendum that saw over ninety percent of Australians vote to give the Commonwealth the power to make laws for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples and recognise them in the national census. It ends on 3 June, which commemorates the 25th anniversary of the High Court of Australia's landmark Mabo decision which legally recognised that Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples have a special relationship to the land, a relationship that existed prior to colonisation and still exists today. This recognition paved the way for land rights or Native Title.
