**ROME – Pope Francis** made the Eucharist the focus of his weekly general audience on 8 November and emphasised the importance of attending and being participant at Mass to fully experience our relationship with God. *“The priest who celebrates Mass says: ‘Lift up your hearts.’ He doesn’t say: ‘Lift up your cell-phones to take a photo.’ This is a bad thing,”* the pope said in an off-the-cuff remark. *“I tell you it makes me very sad when I celebrate Mass here in the square or at the Basilica and I see many cell-phones raised. And it’s not only the faithful, but also many priests and bishops. Please! Mass is not a show!”* Having concluded the series of audiences on the theme of Christian hope, Francis has now begun to address the liturgy and the sacraments. While at Mass *“the Lord is present with us but many times we talk among ourselves, we don’t celebrate being close to him,”* the pope said, adding that while people run to meet famous and important people, many are distracted when God is present at Mass.
