

Weekend Mass: Bookings remain ESSENTIAL

Government and Archdiocesan directives require current **social distancing rules remain in place**, at this stage until the end of October.

Accordingly, St Joseph's Subiaco Parish continues to utilise practices to ensure these safeguards are maintained, including capping numbers attending weekend Masses. Current guidelines limit us to a maximum of 150 attendees per Mass.

Bookings enable us to monitor numbers attending to ensure the mandatory social distancing requirements can be maintained.

There are **two** options for booking.

1. Book online via **TryBooking** (*Our preferred option*).

2. Contact the Parish Office on 9381 0400 if you do not have an email address, access to a computer or are having difficulty booking.

Bookings **open** on **Monday** and **close** at **5pm on Friday**.

If you **have not registered** via TryBooking or the Parish Office **by close of business on Friday**, your **booking is unable to be processed**.

Therefore you will need to arrive early for Mass to sign in and be directed to a seat.

Because social distancing is now usual practice, parishioners attending weekend Masses are asked to maintain this requirement **voluntarily and unsupervised** when **entering** and **exiting** the Church, when **seated** and **during Communion**. Please remember to **sit** in the '**green dot**' designated spaces, and **avoid all pews** marked with a **red dot** (*every second pew*).

Anti-bacterial wipes are available in the pews. Before leaving, please thoroughly **wipe down the area** you have used, and discard utilised towels in the bins provided.
