During the onsite meeting with members of the City of Subiaco and Town of Cambridge engineers, Fr Joe brought to their attention: **a/** Safety of pedestrians is paramount. **b/** Entry/egress to the Church for regular cars also hearses and limousines. **c/** The need for additional street lighting. **d/** Reducing car speed. **e/** Handrails for the pedestrian crossing. **f/** Street closure during Football season. **g/** Issues with the SRA proposed development of the TAFE Site. **h/** Cars using the forecourt of the Church as a turning circle.
